Weston Hub 50 years in our community

Weston Hub was originally called Centre 69 because the building was first opened in 1969 by the Council, and so 2019 marks its 50th Anniversary year.

But it's not the building that we want to celebrate being on Penn Hill Road for 50 years, but the activities that have taken place there over those 50 years and the people that have been involved with them. So many long term residents in Weston remember going to youth clubs and events at Centre 69 right from the earliest days. It was set up as a Youth Centre by the council originally and was run by the Youth Service. Parents and volunteers have helped throughout the years to great effect in an effort to provide activities for bored youngsters and the Centre was extensively used. It then had a name change to Weston Children's Centre run by the council Children's Services Dept and became affiliated with the government driven 'Sure Start' programme. As part of the council's cost cutting exercise, All Saints Church in Weston agreed to take over the running of the building, renamed Weston Hub, from January 2018 in order that the existing groups and activities could continue and that bookings could be increased to make it a sustainable community venue long into the future. All Saints are pleased to report that the project has met expectations in its first year and looks to

be set for a vibrant future. Weston Hub is now an all age community centre and the new regular bookings are starting to reflect this as there are now groups and events for parents with babies right up to fitness activities for older people, with people attending in their eighties and nineties.

Previous groups have stayed on and even expanded. 103 Club now also runs a pre-school during the week along with their breakfast, afterschool and holiday clubs. Enrich Youth Club run on Monday and Thursday evenings and have expanded to run after school drop in sessions.

New groups have started as well. Concept Fitness 65, run by Arthur Perdicchia, is a fitness class specifically designed for the over-60s which has essential functional exercises for mobility, balance, strength and flexibility. Arthur started with one class at 11am on Friday mornings and this year has added another class which is at 12.30pm. There is also WW (Weight Watchers) on a Tuesday evening, Repair Cafe on Saturdays and St John's Mindful Art Workshop on a Tuesday morning, as well as the well established Toybox Toy Library and the Junior Gateway Club on other days.

We are pleased to announce that the Life Project has also moved three of its activities to Weston Hub: Springs, Mini Springs and a Parent/Carer Drop in facility. More on 'Life Project' below. In order to make Weston Hub an attractive venue to use for all these activities, All Saints undertook an extensive internal refurbishment programme at the start of 2018 and wishes to thank, on behalf of the whole community, St. John's Foundation and many other organisations that provided grants to support this and allow it to happen.






