- 2 They will give you a special code. Key this code into the keypad on the cabinet and it will open.
- 3 Get out the defibrillator. The Ambulance Service will tell you what to do

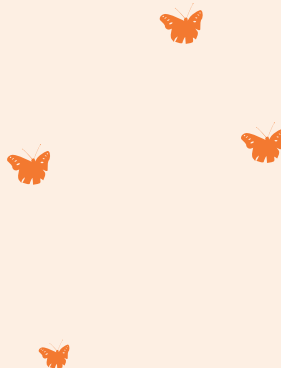

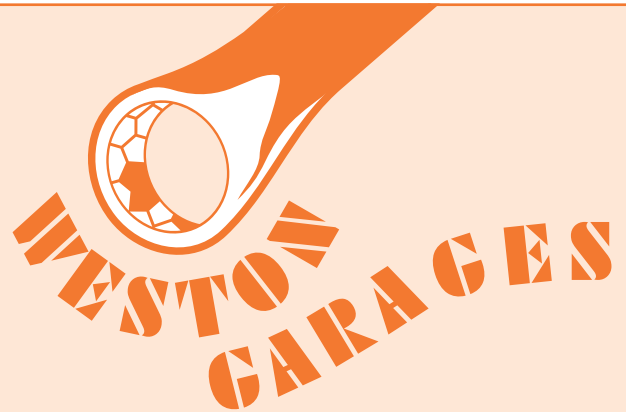
