PCC Report to 2024 APCM

January to December 2023

The PCC met 10 times during 2023, including an extraordinary meeting on 19 February on the ROCK Project and a Weston Benefice PCC & Staff Awayday in September. The Awayday identified the church's spiritual priorities for 2024 and the PCC has since developed these into a series of proposals for welcome, pastoral care, prayer, mission and outreach.

The PCC receives monthly updates on the church's finances and must approve the annual budget, which was signed off in December 2023 for the year to come. There was a marginal surplus for 2023 at the end of December.

The ROCK Project has been a major subject for the PCC's consideration, following its decision in February to proceed with the "reduced scope hybrid" version of the Project. On 2nd October the PCC also made a final "go/no go" decision to implement the Works, and the builders moved in during November. Richard Lewis (Project Manager) and Tom Peryer provided detailed monthly updates on the building project, strategy and fundraising.

The standing items on the agenda include safeguarding, health & safety and governance, staff changes and declarations of any conflicts of interest.

Management groups such as the Standing Cttee, Buildings Cttee and Missions Team are sub-groups of the PCC and the PCC receives regular accounts of their activities and decisions.

The PCC approves new initiatives in pastoral care, mission and outreach and receives feedback on Benefice, City-wide and Diocese matters. Meetings include an update on the care of the church's buildings and premises. This included a change of use for the former Infant's School (previously used by the Scouts); a community housing project initiative, and problems caused by a badger set undermining the car park.

Pippa Page was appointed as Pastoral Co-ordinator from April 2023, taking over from Penny Faux, who stood down at the end of March. The church welcomed Rev Emma King, who was appointed as Curate in June, and said a fond goodbye to David & Claire Parr. Jo Tucker took maternity leave and Rosie Coates was appointed as new Church Warden at the APCM, effective from 3rd October,

when Paddy Gleave stood down. He was thanked for shouldering so many extra responsibilities during the interregnum.

Clive Kennett stood down from the PCC early in 2023. Talitha Garan stood down as PCC Secretary at the APCM in May 2023 and Pat Dunlop took up the role. At the APCM, Anne-Marie Lewis was appointed to the PCC and Rob Gray and Pat Dunlop were co-opted as members.

The role of Parish Safeguarding Officer is now solely in the hands of Karen Kopp, because Clair Hurley stood down in the summer.

The average PCC attendance for 2023 was 76% with 2 members having 100% attendance.
